FLYING "W"

FLYING "W" RACE

A timed event. The Flying "W" race is run with the same poles as used in the Quarter Horse Poles. See diagram below for measurements. Rider may run either a right or left pattern. Rider races to the first pole, turns it, weaving each pole, turns the last pole, and returns crossing the finish line.

EQUIPMENT

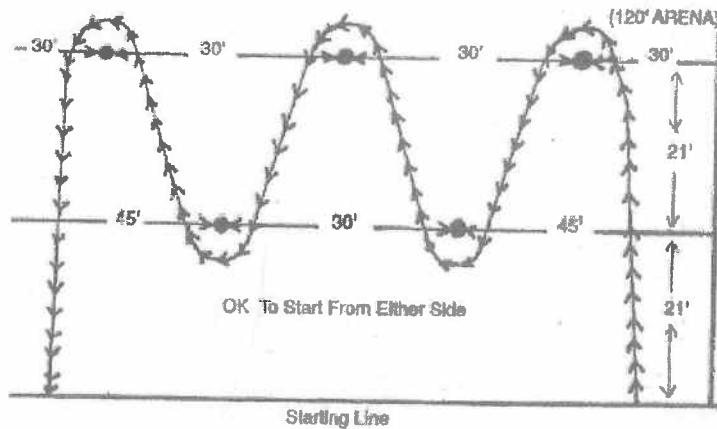
1. The base will be a minimum of 14" to a maximum of 17" in diameter
2. The poles will be a minimum of 6 feet and a maximum of 7 feet in height.
3. PVC cap on the top of each pole.
4. Bases to weigh a maximum of 12 lbs.
5. Five poles made of PVC pipe, a minimum of 1" to a maximum of 1 1/2" in diameter.

PENALTIES

A five (5) second penalty for each pole knocked over.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

1. Failure to complete the pattern
2. Breaking the pattern
