

## PBRC Hitch & Go – RULES & SETUP

### Hitch & Go

#### *Description of Race*

The horse and rider must go through the first set of poles, make a turn around either the left or right pole starting from the inside, continue straight to the second pole make the same direction turn as the first and back through the first set of poles back across the finish line. A right or left-hand pattern may be run.

#### *Equipment*

Four (4) poles, which can be manufactured quarter horse poles, seven (7) feet in height. The bases should be a maximum of seven (7) inches in diameter with rubber hose covering the edge, if metal discs are used. The

maximum weight shall be twelve (12) pounds. The first two poles are ten (10) feet from the start and finish line, ten (10) feet apart. The second set of poles are fifty-five (55) feet from the start and finish line, sixty (60) feet apart.

#### *Judges*

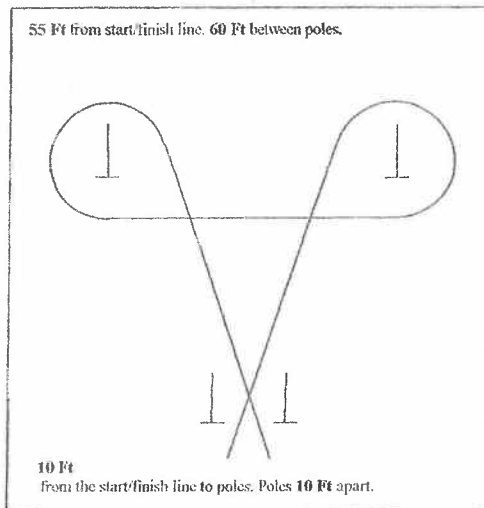
Two (2) judges to observe the pattern and set up the poles in their proper place, if they are knocked over.

#### *Penalties*

A five (5) second penalty for knocking over any pole.

#### *Disqualification*

Breaking the pattern.
